

RETURNING TO WORSHIP

Requirements:

Mandatory Face Masks Over Nose and Mouth

Social Distance at 6 Feet from Others Not In Your Party

Please Use Hand Sanitizer Stations

Avoid Physical Contact

We are working on providing a safe and meaningful worship service for all who would like to attend. Please be aware of the following:

Available pews for seating will be established before you arrive. Related parties should sit together. The floor signs reasonably state, "For Everyone's Health, Please Love One Another From A Safe Distance." Please respect others safe space.

Entering and exiting the Sanctuary will be only through the front doors of the Chapel facing Cocoanut Row. The circle driveway is for drop-off and pick-up only. Doors will open for seating 15 minutes prior to the time of worship. Limited mobility parking will not be available. Parking will be available in the Chapel lot until full, the Flagler Museum parking lots, and on the east side of Cocoanut Row. Parking is never permitted on the residential streets south of the Chapel.

If we reach our safe social distancing capacity in the Sanctuary, the Fellowship Hall will be available for overflow onscreen livestreaming with all safety guidelines in place. If you are not ready to return and choose to worship from the comfort and safety of your home, we celebrate that and encourage you to join us for our YouTube livestreaming at 11:00 a.m.

Most importantly, the success of our safe return and reopening will require cooperation and mutual respect from everyone. We continue to monitor the Florida and County Covid 19 metrics weekly.

Please Be Aware:
