

The Royal Poinciana Chapel

Please Be Aware:

There is a risk of COVID-19 exposure in any public place where people gather. COVID-19 is still highly contagious and can result in illness and death.

Instructions for Worship:

Hand sanitizing, and responsible social distancing in the pews is encouraged for the safety of all.

Entering and exiting the Sanctuary is through the front doors of the Chapel facing Coconut Row. The circle driveway is for drop-off and pick-up only. The Chapel parking lot is reserved for limited mobility parking. Parking for all others is in the Flagler Museum parking lots, and on the east side of Coconut Row. Parking is never permitted on the residential streets south of the Chapel.

We encourage cooperation and mutual respect from everyone and look forward to having you worship with us at the Royal Poinciana Chapel.

Despite our best attempts to provide a safe and meaningful worship service for all who would like to attend, we ask that you be aware of the following items:

There is limited seating in our Sanctuary due to socially distanced seating.

When all seating in the Sanctuary is full, you will be asked to worship in the Fellowship Hall, which has been set up to provide overflow seating that is also socially distanced.

If seating in the Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall reaches the socially distanced capacity, unfortunately we ask that you return home to worship with us online.
